Matt. 23:35 And so upon you will come all the righteous blood that has been shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah son of Berekiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar.

Matt. 25:21 "His master replied, 'Well done, good and faithful servant! You have been faithful with a few things; I will put you in charge of many things. Come and share your master's happiness!'

Luke 2:25 Now there was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Spirit was upon him.

Luke 12:42 The Lord answered, "Who then is the faithful and wise manager, whom the master puts in charge of his servants to give them their food allowance at the proper time?"

John 1:9 The true light that gives light to every man was coming into the world.

John 15:1 "I am the true vine, and my Father is the gardener.

John 17:3 Now this is eternal life: that they may know you, the only true God, and Jesus Christ, whom you have sent.

1Cor. 1:9 God, who has called you into fellowship with his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, is faithful.

Col. 1:2 To the holy and faithful brothers in Christ at Colosse:

Grace and peace to you from God our Father.

Heb. 10:23 Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful.

1Pet. 5:12 With the help of Silas, whom I regard as a faithful brother, I have written to you briefly, encouraging you and testifying that this is the true grace of God. Stand fast in it.

Matt. 25:21 ἔφη αὐτῷ ὁ κύριος αὐτοῦ· εὖ, δοῦλε **ἀγαθὲ** καὶ **πιστέ**, ἐπὶ ὀλίγα ἤς **πιστός**, ἐπὶ πολλῶν σε καταστήσω· εἴσελθε εἰς τὴν χαρὰν τοῦ κυρίου σου.

Luke 2:25 Καὶ ἰδοὺ ἄνθρωπος ἦν ἐν Ἱερουσαλὴμ ᾧ ὄνομα Συμεὼν καὶ ὁ ἄνθρωπος οὗτος **δίκαιος** καὶ **εὐλαβῆς** προσδεχόμενος παράκλησιν τοῦ Ἰσραήλ, καὶ πνεῦμα ἦν **ἅγιον** ἐπ' αὐτόν·

Luke 12:42 καὶ εἶπεν ὁ κύριος· τίς ἄρα ἐστὶν ὁ **πιστός** οἰκονόμος ὁ **φρόνιμος**, ὃν καταστήσει ὁ κύριος ἐπὶ τῆς θεραπείας αὐτοῦ τοῦ διδόναι ἐν καιρῷ [τὸ] σιτομέτριον;

John 1:9 Ἦν τὸ φῶς τὸ **ἀληθινόν**, ὃ φωτίζει **πάντα** ἄνθρωπον, ἐρχόμενον εἰς τὸν κόσμον.

John 15:1 Ἐγὼ εἶμι ἡ ἄμπελος ἡ **ἀληθινή** καὶ ὁ πατήρ μου ὁ γεωργός ἐστίν.

John 17:3 αὕτη δέ ἐστίν ἡ **αἰώνιος** ζωὴ ἵνα γινώσκωσιν σὲ τὸν **μόνον ἀληθινόν** θεὸν καὶ ὃν ἀπέστειλας Ἰησοῦν Χριστόν.

1Cor. 1:9 **πιστὸς** ὁ θεός, δι' οὗ ἐκλήθητε εἰς κοινωνίαν τοῦ υἱοῦ αὐτοῦ Ἰησοῦ Χριστοῦ τοῦ κυρίου ἡμῶν.

Col. 1:2 τοῖς ἐν Κολοσσαῖς **ἀγίοις** καὶ **πιστοῖς** ἀδελφοῖς ἐν Χριστῷ, χάρις ὑμῖν καὶ εἰρήνη ἀπὸ θεοῦ πατρὸς ἡμῶν.

Heb. 10:23 κατέχωμεν τὴν ὁμολογίαν τῆς ἐλπίδος **ἀκλινη**, **πιστὸς** γὰρ ὁ ἐπαγγειλάμενος,

1Pet. 5:12 Διὰ Σιλουανοῦ ὑμῖν τοῦ **πιστοῦ** ἀδελφοῦ, ὡς λογίζομαι, δι' ὀλίγων ἔγραψα παρακαλῶν καὶ ἐπιμαρτυρῶν ταύτην εἶναι **ἀληθῆ** χάριν τοῦ θεοῦ εἰς ἣν στήτε.

1John 2:7 **Ἀγαπητοί**, οὐκ ἐντολὴν **καινὴν** γράφω ὑμῖν ἀλλ' ἐντολὴν **παλαιάν** ἣν εἶχετε ἀπ' ἀρχῆς· ἡ ἐντολὴ ἡ **παλαιά** ἐστίν ὁ λόγος ὃν ἠκούσατε.

1John 3:12 οὐ καθὼς Κάϊν ἐκ τοῦ **πονηροῦ** ἦν καὶ ἔσφαξεν τὸν ἀδελφὸν αὐτοῦ· καὶ χάριν τίνος ἔσφαξεν αὐτόν; ὅτι τὰ ἔργα αὐτοῦ **πονηρὰ** ἦν τὰ δὲ τοῦ ἀδελφοῦ αὐτοῦ **δίκαια**.
